Please note that presentations are meant to be educational and inspiring, not commercial. You may not use your talk or materials solely to promote your products or services.

4. Conference Registration Deadline

Speakers are responsible for registering for the conference no later than 18.03.2026. Failure to comply with the registration deadline may result in your talk being cancelled.

5. Distribution

This ensures that attendees who couldn't join in person can still access and view your talk.
